Stinkwater! 24! Criteria & Entry Guidelines

Criteria

- If your film fits the following criteria (as well as the criteria within the entry form and this website), it's in the running to be screened and possibly win cash and industry prizes.
- Each team must be registered (including the payment of the registration fee along with the signed registration form) prior to 7.30 p.m. on Friday, 2nd February, 2007.
- Your film must be returned (on DVD) to the registration point by 8.00 pm. On Saturday, 3rd February
- Your film must be no longer than 8 minutes, including credits.
- Your film may be scripted prior to the start of the competition, but all other aspects of making the film (including filming, acting, editing, sound etc) must be completed during the 24 hours of the competition.
- Your film must include 5 of the elements selected from a list handed to the team at the beginning of the competition.
- Your film must be shot within the designated geographical area.
- All entries in a language other than English must be sub-titled.
- You must have secured the broadcast rights for all material (including music) and cast used in your film. We can't legally screen your work in public unless these rights have been secured, and we won't (proof that rights have been secured must be supplied).
- That's the main criteria, but check out the entry form page for the fine print.

Entry Guidelines

Registration

It is the producer's responsibility to make sure that the Entry Guidelines and Terms and Conditions of Entry for Stinkwater! 24! are read and understood by all team members.

- Registration takes place at the Cushion Bar courtyard of the Crowne Plaza Coogee between 5.00 p.m. and 7.30 p.m. on Friday, 2nd February 2007.
- At registration teams receive all relevant documentation, event information and instructions.
- At 7.45 p.m., teams assemble in the Cushion Bar courtyard of the Crowne Plaza Coogee (cnr Arden and Carr sts, Coogee) where they will receive an overview of event instructions.
- At the time of Registration, all entry forms must be submitted, if they have not already done so.
- Entry forms must include the Producer's details as well as the details of all team members.

Insurance (very important!)

Stinkwater! 24! Is covered (through Night Sky Productions Pty Ltd) by public liability insurance, however:

- Only officially entered teams and individual team members will be covered. It is therefore compulsory that each member of a participating team for Stinkwater! 24! is acknowledged as a registered participant in the team registration forms.
- If your team or any individual team members are not registered, they will not be covered by insurance.
- Stinkwater! 24!, the Coogee Arts Festival and Night Sky Productions do NOT cover professional indemnity, participants' personal injury or damage to property (third party or otherwise).

- Professional indemnity, participants' personal injury and property damage insurance (third party or otherwise) is the responsibility of the Producer and/or individual participants.
- Stinkwater! 24!'s public liability insurance does not cover anyone who participates unofficially in a team.
- Participants under the age of 18, must have their entry form co-signed by a parent or guardian.

Competition requirements

Films produced for Stinkwater! 24!:

- must be made, dubbed and submitted within a 24 hour period from 8pm Friday 2nd February to 8pm Saturday 3rd February 2007.
- must be made specifically for Stinkwater! 24!
- must be no longer than 8 minutes including titles and credits
- must contain five of the items outlined in Stinkwater! 24! criteria guide provided to the teams on Friday 2nd February (we encourage teams to include the items as creatively as possible).
- will not be accepted after 8pm on Saturday 4th February 2007
- can be shot on any format but must be dubbed onto the DVD supplied on registration night. The DVD is the only one handed in on Saturday night 3rd February 2007.

Information for Filmmakers

- Filmmakers must supply their own camera and any other equipment for the purposes of making their Stinkwater! 24! film
- Filmmakers are allowed to edit their film.
- A Music Release Form will have to be completed and submitted with the film, if music is used in the film
- The Producer must hold the rights to copyright for (or at least the use of) music, voice over, images and performances to enable the film to be shown.
- Copyright and Performance Releases are the Producer's responsibility and must be obtained prior to the completion of the competition.
- All relevant documentation (including all necessary releases) must be submitted with the film on Saturday night 4th February 2007.
- Night Sky Productions takes no responsibility for any breaches of copyright.
- The Producer retains ownership of the entered film.
- Stinkwater! 24! awards prizes for 1st, 2nd and 3rd, as chosen by our panel of judges. All registered teams are eligible for the awards.
